Harvey Elementary School Supplies List 2025-2026 Kindergarten

Hello HES families!

Here is the information that you will need for your child to be prepared for the new school year in September. You are welcome to contact us if you have any questions.

Student Fees:

- \$47.25(\$45 goes to the teacher; \$2.25 goes to School Cash Online) per child or \$42.00 (\$40 goes to the teacher; \$2 goes to School Cash Online) per child if you have 3 or more children at HES.
- Fees will be used to cover the cost of
 - School supplies used within the class
 - Special activities that may occur during the year
- Payment can be made using 1) cash, 2) a cheque made payable to “Harvey Elementary School” or 3) using School Cash Online (register at <https://www.schoolcashonline.com> if you have not yet done so. You will need your child’s last name, first name and date of birth to create a new account). Online payments can be made starting September 6th. Cash and cheques are to be given to your child’s teacher.

Items for you to purchase/pack, and send with your child on the first day of classes, include (please label all items with your child’s name):

- **Book-bag or back-pack** (large enough to hold their lunch box, a communication pouch, extra set of clothes and seasonal clothing – 2 larger zippered compartments with smaller zippered pockets work well)
- **Extra set of clothes** – place in a sealed plastic bag to keep in back-pack for emergencies
- **Lunch box (and Thermos)** – one that is **easily opened and closed** by your child as they access it a few times a day. Students do not have access to

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microwaves, so a thermos may be useful if sending warm food for lunch). It should fit easily into back-pack or book-bag.

- **Kid-friendly containers** - very helpful for little hands when eating snacks or lunch (practice opening & closing them at home). Containers with a silicone seal are helpful for preventing unwanted spills.
- **Indoor sneakers with Velcro closures and non-marking soles** – children need proper footwear when in the gym for Phys. Ed.
- **1 box of tissues**
- **1 box of baggies** – “Medium-sized”, baggies, with the open/close slider-lock (not freezer bags), of any brand
- **1 pkg of baby wipes - unscented**

Kindergarten teachers will send home a postcard the week they return to school to let you know whose class your child will be in. The teachers will also be calling you to find out bussing information to avoid confusion on the first day they are at school.

Staggered entry – families will be contacted as to which day of the first week their child will be attending – **Tuesday, September 2nd or Wednesday, September 3rd. All students will attend on Thursday, September 4th.**

Please ensure that you have given the Administration the most **up-to-date immunization record** for your child. Also, it is a **good idea to ensure your child has had their eyes tested and hearing tested, if they did not go to the “3 ½ year old screening”.**

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
